PROJECT OVERVIEW - MAJOR MILESTONES

1996: Feasibility
Study/Site Selection

1997-2007: Project refinement, NEPA, land acquisition

2008: Phase I Construction of Infrastructure and P&R Lot





2009: Phase II Architectural Design & Engineering for Terminal Building



2012: CSX rejects platform permit without sidetrack; site is no longer cost feasible












GAYNOR AVENUE AMTRAK STATION- SITE

- ☐ 1,800 vehicles/day on Gaynor Avenue between Amtrak Station & Montague Avenue
- ☐ 193 (11%) are vehicles with 6+ tires or 3+ axles











GAYNOR AVENUE AMTRAK STATION- TRAFFIC STUDY

- Traffic Counts in May 2014
- Peak Hour:
 - AM Peak: 7:00 AM 9:00 AM
 - PM Peak: 4:00 PM 6:00 PM
- Peak Hour Assumptions:
 - Office/Leasable/Restaurant: 44 Employees
 - Bus Trips: 13 Buses/Peak Hour (26 Trips)
 - Taxi: 2 Taxi Trips/Peak Hour
- Total Peak Period Activity: 72 Vehicle
 Trips per Peak Hour



Level of Service (Peak Period) AM/PM








TRAFFIC - VEHICLE CIRCULATION

- 7. Rivers to Gaynor One-Way















